BEST WEBSITE

FEPA has launched a competition for philatelic websites under the name "The Francis Kiddle Medal for the Best Philatelic Website".

OVERSEAS EXHIBITIONS

To be eligible for five frames at a FIP, FEPA or other Continental Federation competition, UK collectors must first reach qualifying standard (75 points and vermeil medal) in an ABPS national exhibition. Entries must be made through the UK Commissioner for the event, appointed by ABPS.

In the present unstable circumstances, potential exhibitors should consult the ABPS website for any exhibitions that are going ahead.
